

## EmP06 – Emissions to Air from Processing Plants

---

### What needs to be done?

The following actions need to be taken when an emission to air from a processing plant occurs:

1. Any emissions coming from the plant should be stopped immediately by switching off all plant and equipment
  2. Ensure the responsible manager has been notified
  3. If the emissions are in large quantities, then ensure that the Environment Agency, local authority and local residents are notified
  4. Evacuate the area and wait for assistance to arrive
  5. No further action is required until authorisation has been permitted by the Environment Agency
  6. When practicable, the incident must be formally investigated, recorded and reported using the appropriate forms, including circulation to the relevant authorities.
