

EmP06 - Emissions to Air from Processing Plants

What needs to be done?

The following actions need to be taken when an emission to air from a processing plant occurs:

- 1. Any emissions coming from the plant should be stopped immediately by switching off all plant and equipment
- 2. Ensure the responsible manager has been notified
- 3. If the emissions are in large quantities, then ensure that the Environment Agency, local authority and local residents are notified
- 4. Evacuate the area and wait for assistance to arrive
- 5. No further action is required until authorisation has been permitted by the Environment Agency
- 6. When practicable, the incident must be formally investigated, recorded and reported using the appropriate forms, including circulation to the relevant authorities.
