EmP09 – Disturbance of Protected Species

What needs to be done?

The following actions need to be taken when the disturbance of the habitat of any protected species has occurred:

- 1. Immediately cease operations in the area affected, and inform the responsible manager
- 2. The responsible manager should take immediate action to ensure that the activities of the company do not pose a risk to the protected species and take all possible steps to minimise any disturbance that has already occurred, without further impact
- 3. If necessary, seek guidance from an appropriate ecological consultant or the Environment Agency
- 4. When practicable, the incident must be formally investigated, recorded and reported using the appropriate forms, including circulation to the relevant authorities
- 5. Monitor the condition of the site to ensure all the corrective actions have been effective.
