

EmP10 - Failure of the Ground

What needs to be done?

The following actions need to be taken when a failure of the ground occurs:

- 1. All personnel must report any areas of ground movement observed to the site management immediately (especially at the crest/toe or on slopes)
- 2. Site management shall immediately undertake an inspection of the area, and any other similar areas on site to assess the extent of the movement
- 3. If necessary, operations in the vicinity of the area affected will be ceased
- 4. Site management shall inform the responsible manager of the issue and arrange for a geotechnical consultant to inspect the site as soon as is reasonably practicable
- 5. The geotechnical consultant may advise remedial measures to allow operations to continue
- 6. Such works may need supervision from geotechnical consultants. However, if some immediate work would reduce the potential risk to the environment and/or safety of persons on site, then the responsible manager may decide whether to carry out such works
- 7. When practicable, the incident must be formally investigated, recorded and reported using the appropriate forms, including circulation to the relevant authorities
- 8. Monitor the condition of the site to ensure all the corrective actions have been effective.
