

EmP14 – Identification of Imported Non-conforming Waste

What needs to be done?

The following actions need to be taken when a non-conforming waste is identified in a load imported to the landfill or recycling area:

- 1. When a non-conforming waste is identified in a load the site supervisor or manager must be informed immediately
- 2. If the vehicle which imported the load is still on site, it must be parked up whilst the situation is assessed and necessary actions identified
- 3. If possible, the load (including the non-conforming waste) shall be reloaded
- 4. If the importing vehicle has already left site when the non-conforming waste is identified, the load will be moved to the quarantined waste storage area
- 5. If the waste cannot be moved then work must cease in that area, and the load coned off from other activities
- 6. In all cases, a load rejection form shall be completed, and the responsible manager informed
- 7. If required by the site permit, or waste management licence/exemption, the incident may need to be reported to the Environment Agency.
